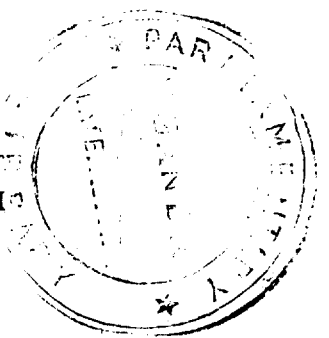

JUSTICE WAMBUZI: Distinguished delegates, I can now call you delegates proper, because having taken the oath you are now in a position to do business, and the first business is the election of Chairman and Deputy Chairman. The Constituent Assembly Statute requires that this Assembly shall have a Chairman and a Deputy Chairman. The

the Statute. The President is required to submit a list of names on the advice of the Cabinet, not exceeding five names. A list has been submitted of five names from which this Assembly will elect a Chairman and also a Deputy Chairman. I am required to introduce to you each person whose names appear on the list submitted by the President and also required to circulate particulars of the qualifications and experience of each nominee. You are then required after due consultations to elect a Chairman and a Deputy Chairman from the Presidential nominees.

I will come to the list later but first I must remind you of some minimum requirements of each nominee. Under the law some qualifications are specified that a person shall not be qualified for election to office of Chairman or Deputy Chairman of the Assembly unless the three conditions given:

1. That he is of high moral character, integrity and impartiality;

2. Has had experience in public affairs or in employment in a high public office for a period of not less than ten years; and

3. He is capable of attending to the duties of the office of Chairman or Deputy Chairman on a full time basis.

Then the relevant law provides that no person shall be elected to the office of chairman or deputy chairman of the Assembly unless a person obtains the votes of two-thirds of all the delegates to the Assembly. It provides also that if at the conclusion of the vote for the election of a chairman or a deputy chairman, no person obtains the number of votes required by law the vote shall be repeated until the chairman or deputy chairman is elected. That is all that the law provides. How do we go about it? I think we should have to agree on some simple procedure of how to do it. It is proposed that we draw up a few rules for ourselves. I have a draft here which I will go over and circulate, we have a look at it and perhaps discuss it and if it is found satisfactory we can perhaps adopt and use it when we come to carry out elections.

We propose that voting shall be by secret ballot using ballot papers supplied by the Commissioner for the constituent Assembly; that the election for the office of chairman shall be held and completed before the election for the office of deputy chairman is held. I propose that on the basis that there are 283 delegates of the Assembly at the time of voting a nominee must obtain votes of 137 or more delegates

to be elected. I think these figures are an example, we shall have to take an actual count of the delegates and then work out a proportion, the proportion is that any successful nominee must have the support of at least two-thirds of the members of the Assembly.

That the following provision shall apply to the casting and counting of votes in respect of those offices of chairman and deputy chairman:

(a) Before voting commences, the Chief Justice shall cause to be produced one ballot box and cause to be demonstrated the fact that it is empty. I think you are familiar with that. The Chief Justice will call upon delegates to vote for the office he specifies and each delegate wishing to vote will write on a ballot paper the name of the nominee for whom he wishes to vote and deposit it in the ballot box. After all delegates who wish to vote have voted, the Chief Justice shall in full view of the delegates present cause officials provided by the Commissioner for the Constituent Assembly under the supervision of the Chief Justice to empty the ballot box and immediately count the ballot papers contained in it. At the completion of counting, the Chief Justice shall announce the result of the votings specifying:

1. the number of votes obtained by each nominee;
2. the number of both spoiled and blank ballot papers. I think after the practice we have had there would not be any; and
3. the total number of ballot papers contained in the ballot box. I hope this will correspond with the number of the delegates.

(b) If a nominee obtains 187 or more votes, he shall be declared by the Chief Justice to have been elected to the office for which the election is held. If upon the first vote no nominee obtains 187 or more votes, voting and counting shall be repeated. In theory it is possible to go on like that and still not obtain the required number. So we propose that if after three votes no nominee has obtained 187 or more votes, a nominee who obtains the lowest number of votes in the third vote shall not be a candidate in subsequent voting for the office the subject of the vote. In other words, if we cannot make up our minds as to who should take the post, perhaps we can make up our minds as to who should cease competing. So we go from the bottom and reduce the number. I hope that will not be necessary either.

The Chief Justice shall then call upon delegates to cast votes for one of the four remaining nominees and if no nominee obtains 187 or more votes, the

nominee who obtained the lowest number shall not be a candidate in the subsequent voting for the office the subject of the vote. You go on taking one by one until you remain with two.

The Chief Justice shall then call upon delegates to cast votes for one of the three remaining nominees and if no nominee obtains 187 or more votes, the nominee who obtained the lowest votes shall not be a candidate in the subsequent voting for the office the subject of the vote, the Chief Justice shall then call upon delegates to cast votes for one of the two remaining nominees and if no nominee obtains 187 or more voting shall be repeated as necessary. I hope that will not be necessary either. This is a draft of suggested rules which will be circulated and we shall consider and discuss it immediately before election and if found satisfactory, we shall follow that.

Now, I would like to go back to the list. As I indicated earlier, Distinguished Delegates, five names have been submitted by the President and it is my pleasure now and duty to introduce them one by one and I would request, I hope the people concerned are around, if I read your name to come up to the rostrum so that you can be identified. The first one is Hon. James Francis Wapakhabulo. You can all see him. *(Applause)*. I think, distinguished delegates, you have seen Hon. Wapakhabulo and just very briefly I think I will be circulating details of qualifications, experience in due course; but very briefly Hon. James Francis Wambogo Wapakhabulo is at the moment a Minister of Tourism, Wildlife and Antiquities. He was born on 23rd of March, 1945, those who can do a little arithmetic can tell his age. Place of birth is Muyembe, Mbale District; his qualifications, he holds a Bachelor of Laws Degree from the University of East Africa Dar-es-salaam; he did a course in Senior Management at the Kenya Institute of Administration, Nairobi in 1976 and he did a course in Legal Drafting, at the Legislative Drafting Institute, Canberra Australia in 1977; he has a post graduate course in legal practice at the Legal Training Institute Port Moresby Papua New Guinea in 1979. His experience: From 1979 to 1983 he was Senior Legislative Draftsman Officer of the Legislative Council of Papua New Guinea; from 1983 to 1986 he was Principal Legal Officer, Ministry of Justice, Papua New Guinea; Assistant Secretary of Justice, Ministry of Justice, Papua New Guinea. In 1986 to 1988 he was Minister of Housing and Urban Development, Vice Chairman Shelta Afric in Nairobi Kenya; in 1988 to 1991 he was Minister of Cooperatives and Marketing, Chairman Interna-

tional Coffee Organisation, London. From 1991 to 1992 he was Minister of Industry and Technology; from 1992 to date he is Minister of Tourism Wildlife and Antiquities.

I think by way of introduction you have seen what he looks like and what he has been through - but I think for this post one of the qualification necessary must be communication. I do not know whether some of you are having difficulty in hearing what I am saying. So, let the Candidates greet the people for not less than three minutes and not more than ten minutes.

(The candidates introduced themselves to the Members of the Assembly.)

JUSTICE WAMBUZI: Distinguished delegates, that brings us to the end of the Presidential list. We can now have some time to consult, to discuss and to think over these names and when we meet again on Tuesday, 17th at 9.30 we shall proceed with the election of the Chairman and Deputy Chairman. Before we rise, I believe the secretariate has one or two announcements to make.
